1.0 Purpose

To define the circumstances when a non-member of the LBC can participate in an event or activity on the greens at the LBC.

2.0 Policy Details

1. A guest is any bowler who is not a member of the BBC LBC and is not a registered participant in an OLBA or other tournament taking place at the BBC LBC.
2. A guest may or may not be a member of the BBC.
3. Guests who are not BBC members are required to be signed in at the main club and pay the \$15.00 fee for use of a sport facility.
4. Prospective new LBC members are not considered guests and are allowed to participate in up to 4 training sessions at the beginning of the season.
5. During the season a member may bring a maximum of 2 guests to Skills and Drills and Aussie Pairs and a maximum of 4 guests to open bowling. The member is responsible for ensuring guests are aware of proper delivery technique to minimize damage to the greens.
6. Members are encouraged to limit their guests to 4 visits in the season.
7. Guests cannot register for jitneys. They may participate only if space is available after all registered and waitlisted members are assigned to teams on the day of the jitney.
8. Upon request, BBC members can be added to the “Social” mailing list so that they are aware of registration timing and process for the next season.
