1.0 Purpose

To outline rules regarding the consumption of alcohol on the lawn bowling property.

2.0 Policy Details

1. Alcohol is never permitted on the greens.
2. In order to serve alcohol in the area immediately adjacent to the clubhouse (never on the greens), a Special Occasions Permit must be obtained from the city through the Club Manager of the Balmy Beach Club. The main club then provides staff and the alcohol for the event, and revenues belong to the main club.
3. If a Special Occasions Permit is obtained for a Corporate Event, LBC volunteers at the event cannot consume alcohol until the bowling is over. Volunteers are not to indulge in any alcoholic drinks during play on the greens, even if offered by the Corporate Event host.
4. In the absence of a Special Occasions Permit, alcohol is not allowed anywhere on lawn bowling property (clubhouse, area outside clubhouse, or on the greens) at any time. Failure to comply with this rule could result in the loss of the liquor licence at the main club for up to 6 months.
5. Rule 4 applies to LBC members, guests and participants of Corporate Events.
6. The liquor licence in the clubhouse is under the BBC licence. It allows consumption of alcohol in the clubhouse without a Special Occasions Permit but with the same rules: The main club provides staff and the alcohol for the event, and revenues belong to the main club.
